Best suited for: Early Years Foundation Stage **Duration:** 40 minutes plus time to explore

Overview:

Meet a sleepy Blackpool tourist as they tell you all about their perfect day at the seaside. Learn about all the things they've seen and done as we look back at Blackpool's history as one of the nation's favourite seaside resorts.

Best suited for: Key Stage 1 and 2

Duration: 2 hours including time to explore

Each Key Stage will enjoy two hands on and engaging activities linked to the National curriculum.

Immerse yourself in the seaside with our sensory seaside workshop. A day at the seaside is perfect for relaxing and taking everything in.


What can you see, smell, touch, taste and hear when you visit the seaside? Use your senses to explore a day by the sea.
